**Tokyo-Mt. Fuji**

After breakfast, visit Senso-ji Temple, which is the oldest temple in Tokyo, and enjoy the vibrant stalls of Nakamise Dori. View the tallest standing tower in the world – Tokyo Skytree from afar. Then, visit the famous Nijubashi Bridge, which is outside of the Imperial Palace out gardens. Later, head for Shinjuku Kabukicho. Finally, transfer to Hot Spring Hotel near Mt. Fuji Area and enjoy Japanese-Style hot spring and dinner.

Special adding spots in Spring(Departure date 22nd Mar-12th Apr): Chidorigafuchi Park, Shinjuku Gyoen  
Special adding spots in Autumn(Departure date 18th Oct-15th Nov): Yoyogi Park, Rikugien Garden

**Day4**

**Mt. Fuji-Nagoya**

In the morning, visit Mt. Fuji 5th Station, located halfway up the mountain (If weather not permitting, go to Mt. Fuji World Heritage Center instead). Then, head to Oshino Hakkai with the traditional buildings and amazing view of Mt. Fuji. Then go to Bussharito Heiwa Park to appreciate the gardening featured with Japanese characteristics. Later, transfer to Nagoya and stroll on the famous Osu Shopping District. Dinner is on your own arrangement.

**Nagoya-Kyoto**

After breakfast, visit the Nagoya Castle, one of the most important castle towns in Japan. Then transfer to Kyoto. Visit the Kiyomizu-dera Temple, a World Cultural Heritage site, and stroll along the Sannenzaka & Ninenzaka Streets. Afterwards, head to Gion, a good place to experience the ancient culture of Kyoto. The Yasaka Shrine is a bustling downtown shrine. Walk on Hanamachi Street, the most stylish geisha district in Japan. Dinner is on your own arrangement.

Special adding spots in Autumn(Departure date 18th Oct-15th Nov): Arashiyama Area-Togetsukyo Bridge

**Day6**

**Kyoto-Osaka**

After breakfast, visit Fushimi Inari Taisha Shrine. The path of vibrant orange torii gates is one of the most famous images of Japan. Afterward, head to Nara Park where full of friendly deer. And don't miss the beautiful view in Kasuga Taisha Shrine. Visit the landmark Osaka Castle Park (tower/museum excluded). This evening, visit the shopping district Shinsaibashi and taste the local cuisine at Dotonbori Street. Dinner is on your own arrangement.

**Day7**

**Osaka(KIX)/Seoul(ICN)- Gangwon-do**

After breakfast, take shuttle bus to airport(ticket included and guide will assist the day before) and fly to Korea. Upon arrival, our guide will pick you up. Then, transfer to Gangwon-do and enjoy local cuisine tonight. Lunch is on your own arrangement.

**Gangwon-do- Seoul**

After breakfast, go to Seoraksan National Park(cable car included), which is one of the eastern peaks of South Korea located in a famous tourist attraction in Gangwon-do and visit Shinhungsa Temple. Visit Sokcho Tourist & Fishery Market, an essential tourist attraction in Sokcho, offers all sorts of things. Later, visit the Petite France, a French cultural village designed with the theme concept, "flowers, stars, and the Little Prince". Later on, transfer to Seoul.

**Day9**

**Seoul**

After breakfast, transfer to the Korean Demilitarized Zone. Odusan Unification Observatory is at the top of Mt. Odu, which stands 118m above sea level and overlooks the confluence of the Han and Imjin Rivers. This is also the site of Korean division. Visit the Imjingak Park, which has various war-related artifacts. Freedom Bridge is a former railroad bridge which was used by repatriated POWs/soldiers returning from the north. Afterwards, visit National Museum of Korea, here houses a vast collection of over 420,000 artifacts from ancient times to the modern era in a wide range of topics. Bugak Skyway is a popular tourist attraction that offers one of the best panoramic views of downtown Seoul. Dinner is on your own arrangement.

**Day10**

**Seoul**

After breakfast, have a stop at the Blue House, a public park that formerly served as the presidential residence. Then, visit the Imperial Palace of the Joseon Dynasty - Gyeongbokgung Palace. Ikseon-dong is a place where the harmony of alleys and hanok houses exudes beautiful charm and is a must-visit spot for tourists of all ages and genders. Take the Han River Cruise and enjoy the charming scenery on both sides while facing the refreshing breeze. Enjoy yourself in the famous shopping center Myeongdong. Dinner is on your own arrangement.
